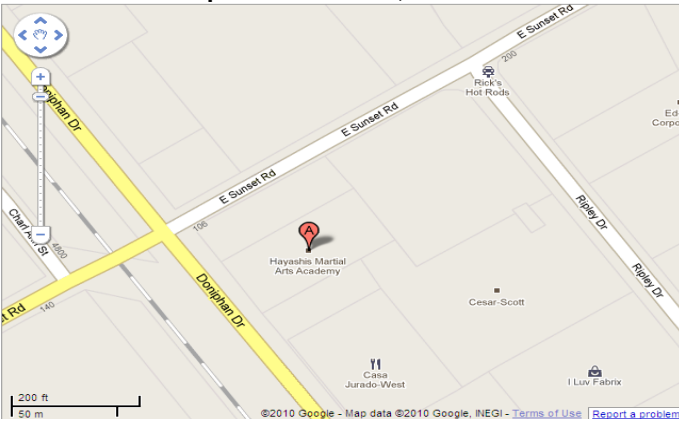

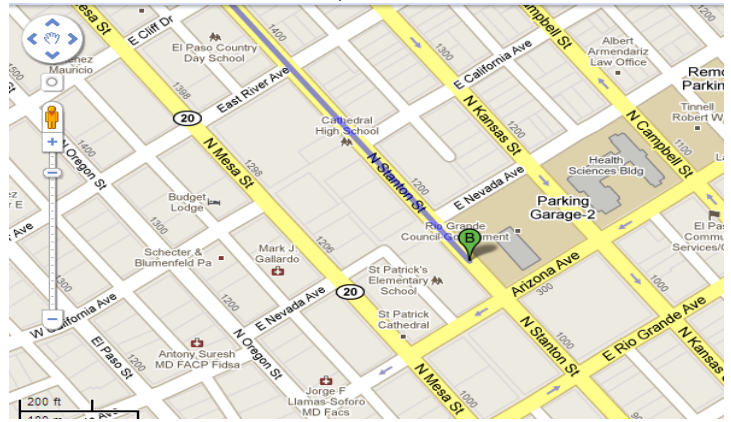
## DIRECTIONS FROM HAYASHI'S DOJO TO CATHEDRAL HIGH SCHOOL:

# HAYASHI'S JUJITSU AND NO - GI SUBMISSION GRAPPLING METHOD OF COMPETITION

**METHOD OF COMPETITION:** Modified double elimination system for divisions with 6 or more competitors (all competitors are guaranteed 2 matches). Divisions with 5 or less competitors will go by round robin system.  
Time lengths: Youth Divisions (ages 16 and under) – **3 Minutes**; Adult Divisions (ages 17 and up) – **4 Minutes**. This is a high energy, fast paced tournament, competitors are encouraged to finish their matches by submission in the quickest amount of time possible, while using control and following all rules and regulations stated below.

**GENERAL RULES:** All competitors and spectators must be off of the mats if not competing. Referee and Judges have authority to issue warnings/ disqualification if deemed necessary due to (competitor) disregard of tournament rules and regulations, or un-sportsman like behavior (**on or off** of the competition area). Spectators and non-competitors must stay outside of the secluded area as it is only for staff and competitors. Any obscene, deviant, disrespectful, or un-sportsman like behavior will not be tolerated, and you will be asked to gather your belongings and will be walked out the door by an appointed staff member.

**WAY OF VICTORY/ POINT SYSTEM:** Win is achieved by the following: 1. **Submission** is acknowledged when the opponent submits by either physical tap or verbal submission, deemed as an admittance of surrender. 2. Hold majority of **points** at end of match, due to dominance, transitions, and control of positions. A Pin is counted when you have full top control without your opponent controlling you; meaning if you chose to; you could abandon the pin and not be in danger of being controlled. 3. **Referee stoppage** due to opponent disqualification, forfeit, no contest, injury, accidental knock out or choke out, deems fighter is unable to continue. In the event of a tie (no score or both fighters have same number of points) there will be a two minute overtime round. Overtime will consist of throws and takedowns only, ground fighting will be limited to a few seconds, if no progress is made quickly, you will be restarted from standing. In order to win the overtime round first point wins the match.

### Scoring system

Throws/ Take Downs – **2 points** (land in top control over opponent)  
Pins – **2 points** (must be held for 4 seconds)  
Sweeps – **2 points** (must end up in a controlling position)  
Knee on Belly – **2 points** (must be held for 3 seconds)  
Guard Pass – **2 points** (must end up in controlling position)  
Taking the Back – **2 points** (must have both hooks in)

**SUBMISSION MOVES:** despite whatever points either fighter has accumulated, securing a submission wins the fight. All fighters are greatly encouraged to test their skill however needed, just remember achieving a submission is superior to points.

### Youth Divisions (ages 7 – 16)

submissions from the waist up only  
All Arm bars/ Locks  
All Chokes  
No leg locks of any kind will be permitted  
No neck cranks will be permitted

### Adult Divisions (ages 17 +)

Arm bars/ Locks  
Chokes  
Knee bars  
Calf/Bicep crushers  
Straight Ankle Locks (on same side of body, not crossing)  
Straight Neck Cranks (no twisting or backward neck cranks)  
No Heel Hooks or Toe Holds will be permitted

**FOULS/ ILLEGAL MOVES:** **No:** Heel Hooks, Toe Holds, slamming a grounded opponent/ power bombing from the guard position or triangle position (once your opponent is 6 inches off the ground you will be restarted from standing position), No striking of any form will be allowed, head butting, eye gouging, hair pulling, grabbing of the shorts in No-Gi divisions (gi divisions are allowed to grab gi material), biting, scratching, pressure points, talking to opponent or sidelines during the fight, stalling (purposefully remaining idle or refusing to fight), small joint manipulation (at least 4 fingers or toes must be held if grabbing small joints), attacking the groin, attacking the windpipe, Throwing an opponent off the mat or intentionally moving out of the competition area.

**ATTIRE/ HYGIENE:** No Shoes will be worn on the mats. All fighters must wear clean attire (gis, shorts, rash guards, etc.) If referee or judges feel your hygiene is questionable you will not be allowed to compete. Gis, and shorts must not be torn. Shorts must not have external pockets. Fight gear allowed at this tournament: **tape, ankle guards, knee pads, rash guards, ear guards, mouth piece, and groin protector**. Required gear: Gi divisions must have a Judo or Jujitsu gi. No-gi divisions, nothing less than fight shorts are required.

**JUDO DIVISIONS:** This year will be a **Non-Sanctioned** Judo Tournament. Judo Insurance cards are not necessary; will not be checked. This will be freestyle Judo rules; the new leg attack takedown rules will be overruled by Hayashi's Rules. Takedowns and throws involving leg attacks **will** be allowed.

**JUDO VICTORY/ POINT SYSTEM:** To achieve a win in Judo you must score an Ippon (one full point). A complete throw where opponent is slammed on their back is one full point (Ippon). An incomplete throw (when opponent lands in a compromising position) will count as a wazaari (half point). Pins must be held for 30 seconds to score a full point (Ippon). If a pin, submission, or advancement of position is not achieved immediately after an incomplete throw, fighters will be restarted from standing position. In Judo grappling on the ground is very brief, length of time will depend on the referee's judgment. No submissions below the waist are allowed in Judo.

Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
5. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo, Inc., the United States Olympic Committee, United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, Texas Judo Inc. **Hayashi' Martial Arts Academy, Zen Bujutsukan Federation, Cathedral High School and any other affiliated parties**, and all judo organizations and local organizations supporting the event together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors, and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "releasee", from any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including permanent disability and death and damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise to the fullest extent permitted by law.
